The shops display a fascinating array of period merchandise, from toys, gramophones, wirelesses and cameras to costume jewellery, clothes and haberdashery. From nail, glass, button and salt making to the international reputation of the Bromsgrove Guild who made the gates for Buckingham Palace, the Liverpool Liver Birds and many other historic pieces.
