Science & Technology in Society

Despite the fact that we live in an age where the impact of Science and Technology on our lives is enormous and continually increasing, many people do not have a very clear idea about the nature of these two human activities, what benefits we can expect them to offer to mankind, and what their reasonable limitations might be.

This group will set out to explore the ways in which both Science, and Technology, as uniquely human activities, actually work, the relationship between the two, and the ways in which they both, acting together, influence our lives. The group should look at a wide range of areas of interest, but should also be capable of considering moral and ethical issues, and the ways in which concerned members of society can influence these activities.

It is not intended that this group should only interest people with a background in either Science or Technology, though the input from such people will be very valuable. The intention is that issues broached will be of interest and relevance to anyone who is a concerned member of modern western society.

The format of the sessions will centre around talks, discussion and formation of working parties.

A preliminary meeting took place on 7th April. from 10.00 to 12.00. The meetings will be monthly for the time being, and will be held in the upstairs function room of the Rock Tavern at 80 Wilden Lane, Stourport DY13 9LR.

The first 'full' meeting will take place on Monday 20th April at 10am.

A very wide range of topics of potential interest were considered at that preliminary meeting, and also a wide range of different ways in which they could be addressed, so this promises to be an interesting and lively group; do come along and join us!
